

Items that present a hazard and can NOT be shipped on a moving truck/trailer:

Aerosol cans, Ammonia, Ammunition, Car batteries, Charcoal/lighter fluid, Chemicals in a liquid form,

Cleaning solvents, Fertilizer, Fire extinguishers, Fireworks, Fuels/oils, Household batteries, Kerosene, Liquid bleach, Loaded guns, Matches, Nail polish, Paint thinners, Paints/varnishes, Pesticides Poisons, Propane tanks, Weed killer.

Perishable items that can NOT be loaded and shipped on a moving truck/trailer:

Food without adequate preservation, Frozen food, Open or half-used foods, Plants, Produce, Refrigerated foods.

Items of sentimental value and/or Items that SHOULD be kept with you when you move:

Address books Airline tickets, Car titles Cash Cell phones,
Computer data, files/backups, Family photographs/photo albums,
Financial documents (stocks, bonds, CDs, IRAs, deeds, tax records),
Home videos, Insurance policies, Jewelry and furs,
Keys (car, furniture, new home) Laptop computers, Medical/dental records,
New home documents, Prescription medicine Professional files/research
projects, School records.
